## **Tournament Details**

**Venue:** Leeming Primary School, 10 Meharry Road, Leeming, WA 6149

Format: Swiss (Dutch variant), with 6 rounds, to be rated on the March 2019 ACF Classic list. Vega software

(with the JaVaFo engine) will be used for pairings. FIDE Laws of Chess apply.

<u>Time Control</u> Playing Times:

60 minutes initial time, with 10 seconds increment per move.

#### **Prizes**

Cash prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, plus separate rating division prizes, depending on entries.

#### Mobile phone rule:

During games, possession of communication devices and other electronic devices capable of suggesting chess moves is strictly forbidden. While a player's games are in progress, all such devices that he/she has brought to the venue must be completely switched off and stored either in a separate bag, or under his/her table, or in the secure room that is provided by the organiser. Spectators and players whose games in the current round have finished are not bound by this rule, but we ask that phones be kept on silent mode so as not to disturb the players.
