The winning school in each division qualifies to compete in the Australian Schools Teams Championship!

Location:

Rosalie Primary School,
101 Onslow Road, Shenton Park WA 6008
Parking available on the oval off Derby Road.

Format: 7 round swiss, with a time control of 12min + 3sec increment.

Divisions: Primary and Secondary.
Run as two separate events simultaneously. Players from the same school cannot play each other. School scores are determined by adding up the scores of the top four players from each school.

Prizes: Trophies for individual 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Medals for the top four scoring players from placing schools.

The top scoring primary school to be awarded the title of WA Primary Girls School Champions.
The top scoring secondary school to be awarded the title of WA Secondary Girls School Champions.
