Location:

Nedlands Primary School,
35 Kingsway, Nedlands WA 6009

Format: 7 round swiss.

Divisions: Primary and Secondary; run as two separate events simultaneously. Players from the same school cannot play each other. School scores are determined by adding up the scores of the top four players from each school.

Time Control: 20min + 3sec increment
Participants not familiar with chess timers should arrive at the venue early to practice.

Prizes: Trophies for individual 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Trophies for the top four scoring players from the schools coming 1st, 2nd and 3rd. School trophy awarded for the winning school in each division.

The top two schools in each division automatically qualify for the SCL Finals!

Titles: The top scoring primary school to be awarded WA SCL West Zone Primary Champions.
The top scoring secondary school to be awarded WA SCL West Zone Secondary Champions.
