Tournament Details

- Venue:** Southern Suburbs Chess Club, Leeming Primary School (Meharry Road, Leeming).
- Format:** Swiss (Dutch), 7 rounds, ACF rated. Pairings by Vega (with the JaVaFo engine). FIDE Laws of Chess apply. Appendix A (Rapid chess) applies, with Article A.4.
- Tiebreaks:** In order of decreasing priority: Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz Total, Direct Encounter, ARO1.
- Time Control:** 15 minutes initial time, with 2 seconds increment per move starting from move 1.
- Default Time:** Any player who arrives at their board after a flag has fallen shall forfeit their game.
- Half-point byes:** No half-point byes will be awarded.
- Schedule:** First round 12:00pm then 12:45pm; 1:30pm; 2:15pm; 3:00pm; 3:45pm; 4:30pm.
Prize giving at 5:15pm.
- Closing Date:** Saturday 30th April.
Late entries accepted until 11:45am on Sunday 1st May subject to a \$5 late entry fee.
- Entry Fee:** \$20 (on or before Saturday 30th April)
\$25 (on Sunday 1st May before 11:45am)
Players must be members of the Chess Association of WA.
- Mobile phone rule:** During games, possession of communication devices and other unauthorised electronic devices is strictly forbidden. While a player's games are in progress, all such devices that he/she has brought to the venue must be completely switched off and kept either in a separate bag, under his/her table, or face-down on the table. Spectators and players whose games in the current round have finished are not bound by this rule, but we ask that phones be kept on silent mode so as not to disturb the players.
