Russian Grand Master J. Eduard Gufeld visited Perth in 1986. After a simultaneous exhibition at the Willetton Sports Club, Eduard's offer to provide a perpetual trophy to the club was gratefully accepted. This was to be the Gufeld Cup, played over three days of Easter in a seven round open tournament. After disbandment of the Willetton Club, the Gufeld Cup has become a key event in the CAWA Grand Prix, always held over the Easter weekend.

Format: Swiss (Dutch variant), with 6 rounds, to be rated on the June 2023 ACF Classic list. Vega software (JaVaFo engine) for pairings. FIDE Laws of Chess apply.

Time Control: 60 minutes with 10 second increment from move 1.
