Divisions: Primary and Secondary; run as two separate events simultaneously. Players from the same school cannot play each other. School scores are determined by adding up the scores of the top four players from each school.

Time Control: 20min + 3sec increment Participants not familiar with chess timers should arrive at the venue early to practice.
