Venue:	Lichess Online Chess Server: <u>http://lichess.org</u>
Format:	Swiss (Dutch), 7 rounds, not rated by ACF. lichess.com pairings will be used. FIDE Online Chess Regulations apply: <u>https://handbook.fide.com/files/handbook/OnlineChessRegulations.pdf</u> Players and parents should be conversant with the essential elements of these rules.
Instructions:	In order to participate in this tournament, players will first need a lichess account. This can be created free of charge by following the link above. How to set up a lichess account: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rCO-HNoN0Mo</u>
	Parents of all participants will need to read the following documents, available from <u>www.cawa.org.au</u> : (1) 2022 CAWA SCL Northern Zonal Setup Information (2) 2022 CAWA SCL Northern Zonal Rules and Regulations We will be using Whatsapp to communicate information to players and their parents. It is essential that you join the 2022 WA North Zonal SCL Whatsapp group. The link to join will be emailed to you with confirmation of your entry. The Whatsapp group is monitored by CAWA officials, and players/parents should ask questions here.
	Once the player has created his/her lichess account, they must then join the correct Team for their tournament in lichess.org . Teams can be accessed from the Community menu.
	Primary students must join the Team <u>WA Primary March 20</u> by Thurs 17 th March. Secondary students must join Team <u>WA Secondary March 20</u> by Thurs 17 th March. Only players who have both paid their entry fee <u>and</u> registered in the appropriate team will be admitted to the tournament.
	To ensure Fair Play, video surveillance will be used during these online tournaments. Players and parents should carefully read the documents "Setup Information" and "Rules and Regulations" for information on how to set up the necessary cameras and live stream to the arbiters. Each player's camera setup will be tested for approval during a trial run, to be held on Friday 18 th March. Only players whose setup has been approved in advance by the Chief Arbiter will be permitted to play on 20 th March.
Schedule:	12 noon – 6:00pm.
Closing Date:	Thursday 17 th March. Late entries may be accepted until 7:00pm on Friday 18 th March, but will be subject to a \$10 late entry fee. There will be a <u>maximum capacity of 100 players</u> – first come, first served.
