The Perth Chess Academy meets on seven weekends each term at Perth Modern School and is available to anyone between the ages of 5 and 17. The main instructor for all classes is experienced chess coach Jay Lakner.

All classes are held in the Parsons Building. (parking: car Park No. 4 off Subiaco Road.)

The academy consists 4 different class levels:

Beginners Class Meets 9.00am - 10.30am Saturdays

Max Class Size: Appropriate for students new to chess. Here students learn the rules of chess and some

<u>Development Class</u> Meets **11.00am – 12.30pm Saturdays** or **9.00am – 10.30am Sundays**Max Class Size: Appropriate for students who know all the rules and have a bit of experience but are

Advanced Class Meets 1.00pm – 2.30pm Saturdays

Max Class Size: Appropriate for students with a lot of experience and have a good grasp of basic tactics.

Master Class Meets 3.00pm – 6.00pm Saturdays

Max Class Size: This class features some of the top junior chess players in WA. Each term the class runs an No limit ACF-rated 7-round Swiss tournament with a time control of 60min. All games are thoroughly

analysed, and a weekly report is provided.

The instructor tries to ensure that students are in the class which will most benefit them. Therefore, if part-way through the term, the instructor believes a student is registered for a class of inappropriate level, he will collaborate with the student and parent to suggest a more appropriate level which they can immediately switch to.
