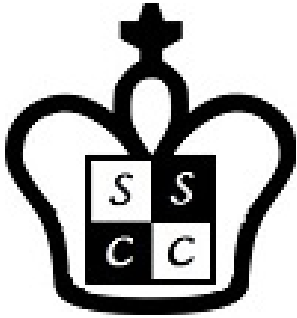

Southern Suburbs Junior Chess Club is suitable for all chess players between 8 and 17 years of age. SSJCC is aimed at chess enthusiasts of all levels, from beginners up to experienced tournament players.

When: Tuesdays 5:30 – 6:30pm, 7th February – 12th December.

Note: SSJCC does not run during school holidays.

Where: Undercover/Assembly Area, Leeming Primary School, Leeming.

Session Fees: No fee for SSJCC or SSCC members.
\$5 per session for non-members.

Provisions:

Chess equipment and clocks, free parking, refreshments for players.

In club sessions, children will receive training, solve problems, participate in friendly matches and play tournament games against opponents of various levels.

Players should know the rules of chess before attending, and must bring their own pens/pencils to record their games and to complete worksheets.

SSJCC Membership: Semester 1 (February – June): \$30 per player
Semester 2 (July – December): \$30 per player

SSJCC is run by Southern Suburbs Chess Club (SSCC). SSCC (established in December 2014) is intended for adult and experienced junior players, and meets at 7:30pm on Tuesdays, at the same venue.

Both of our clubs (SSCC and SSJCC) are affiliated with the Chess Association of Western Australia. Players do not need to join the CAWA in order to join SSJCC or participate in unrated junior tournaments. However, players that wish to participate in rated tournaments or join adult clubs must join CAWA.

Southern Suburbs Chess Club will take robust measures to maximise the safety of attendees and to ensure that suitable adult supervision is provided. However, if a parent/guardian believes that their child is likely to require high levels of supervision, then they must take responsibility for this.
