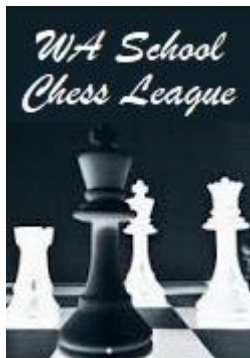

2019 WA School Chess League Central Zone



The CAWA School Chess League Central Zonal qualifying was held on Sunday, 9th June at Mount Lawley Primary School.

It had a fair number of participants with a combined total of 42 players from 20 Primary and Secondary schools.

Results of the Top 3 schools for both divisions are as follows:

Primary Division: 1st - Mount Lawley Primary School, 2nd - Victoria Park Primary School, 3rd - Rosalie Primary School

The competition for the division's individual honour was won by Anthony Nguyen (Victoria Park PS) who upset Harry Geronimo (Forest Crescent PS) in Round 6 due to time pressure/flag down. Harry eventually placed 2nd and won silver medal. The battle for 3rd place was won by Barath Harirajesh (East Maddington PS) after finishing the final round with a tied score with Yonal De Vas (Caladenia PS), and Barath eventually snaring the bronze medal after winning the playoff match.

Secondary Division:

1st - Perth Modern School, 2nd - Trinity College, 3rd - Shenton College

*** Thornlie Senior High School just missed out the bronze medal, only one point behind Shenton College.

The individual title for the division was won by Jaime Laubbacher (Perth Modern School) with a perfect score of 7 wins from 7 games. Highlight of the division was the win of Jaime upsetting Brent Geronimo (Thornlie Senior HS) in Round 4 with both players in time pressure and Brent losing due to flag down and Jaime with just 10seconds left on his clock. Brent and Minh Nguyen tied for 2nd place both with 6 points, with Brent eventually snaring the silver medal after winning the playoff match with Minh who settled for the bronze medal.

Secondary - Perth Modern School (37points), Trinity College (34), Corpus Christi College (22), Shenton College (15), Aquinas College (14), Thornlie Senior HS (13), All Saints College (11), Carmel School (11), and Sacred Heart College-Sorrento (10points).

2019 WA Chess Championships



The 2019 WA Chess Championships was played at Leeming Primary School from the 26th May to 7th July.

This year's event was the strongest Closed Championship to be held in WA for quite a few years. Moreover, with 34 players, it was the best attended WA Championship for at least 10 years. My thanks go to all of you for playing and to everyone who contributed to the success of this year's Championships, especially:

- Leeming Primary School, for making their venue available for us to use at a generously discounted rate for the 7-week duration of the tournament;
- Chess Association of WA, for sponsoring the WA Chess Championships prize pool to the tune of approximately \$1,000 each year;
- CAWA President Alan Wolstencroft, for providing players with milk and biscuits each week, which were well received, and for replenishing the club's tea and coffee supplies whenever we ran short of anything, as well as plenty of other work behind the scenes;
- The dedicated parents, for bringing their children to the tournament and picking them up every week, and in many instances, having to wait long periods of time for games to finish;
- The many players who arrived early and stayed late each week to help set up and pack away chess equipment and furniture.

The tournaments will be submitted for FIDE and ACF rating. Three players in the WA Reserves Championship -- Dylan Gough, Malindu Premaratna, and Kundan Dharmapuri -- will gain their first FIDE ratings from this tournament.

There will be two playoff matches. These will be held at Perth's three main senior clubs on weeknights, over the next two weeks.

Well done to all of the following winners (playoffs pending). Perpetual trophies will be awarded at the CAWA Harris Interclub Competition, to be played on Sundays 28th July and 4th August.

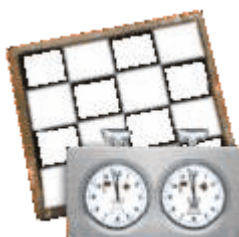

He introduced many quality juniors to this Club including Yita Choong, Leon and Natalie Taylor and Zhengbo Wang. A display of Bob's memorabilia was set up in the front room at the AGM. In recognition of the outstanding contribution Bob has done for this Club, the Committee have now renamed the Metro Open to the Robert (Bob) Pilgrim Open.
