Well done to all participants!

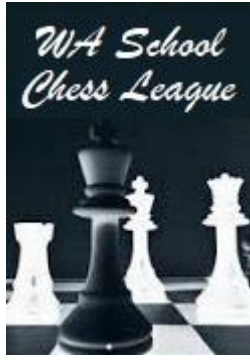
While the field was not as big as we had hoped for, the quality of the chess was very high and all players seemed to enjoy their weekend.

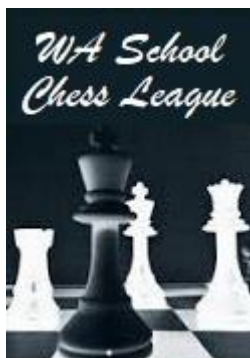

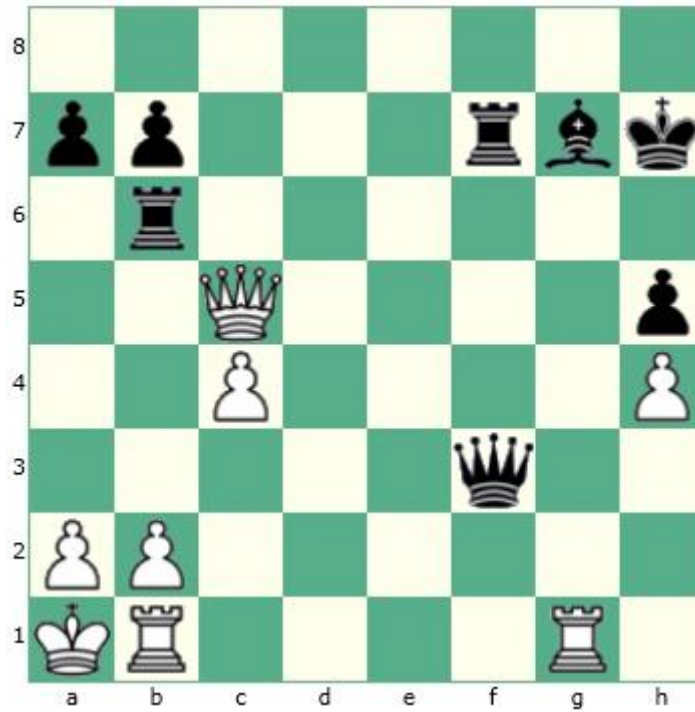

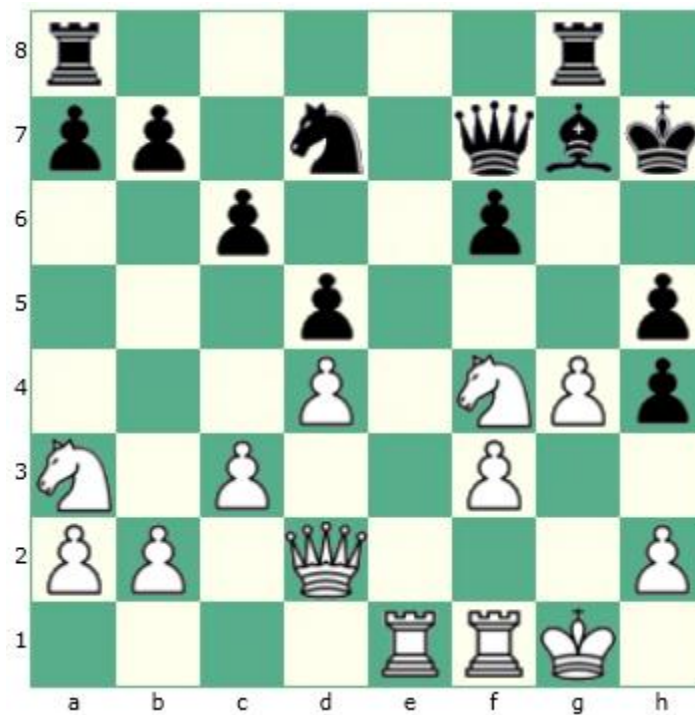
2019 Bernard Anton Shield (1)

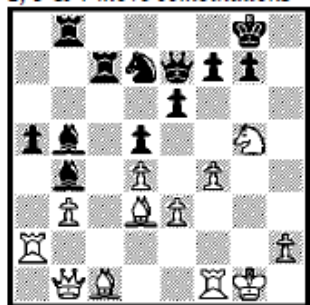
Puzzle 1: How can Black force an immediate win?



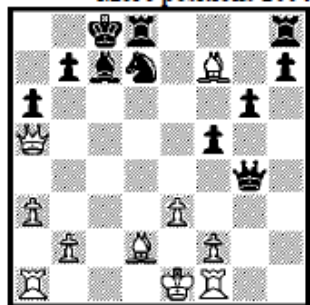
Puzzle 2: Can you spot White's immediate win?
