PLAYING TIME

The tournament will take place on Sunday, 17th March, from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm. To facilitate the registration check process, we kindly request that all participants arrive by 11:30 am. The pairing for the first round will be conducted on Saturday evening. If, for any reason, you are unable to attend the first round, you may request a half-point bye for round 1 only by sending an email to chessassociationwa@gmail.com before noon on Saturday, 15th March 2024.

Registration for this event closes on Friday, 15th March 2024 at 18:00.

Once we reach maximum capacity, registration will be closed but players will be put on a waiting list. If a spot becomes available due to a cancellation, we will notify those on the waiting list on a first-come, first-served basis within 48 hours of the event. Tickets are NON refundable in monetary value but may be refunded as a voucher for future tournaments, at the discretion of the organizers, on a case-by-case basis.

PRIZES

- Trophy for the Top three Primary / Secondary schools.
- Trophies for the Top four Primary / Secondary School team members of the winning schools.
- Trophies for the Top three players and the Top girl in the Primary and Secondary divisions.

Kindly take note that to be eligible for any individual prize, a player must achieve a score of 50% or greater (i.e., 3.5/7). If two or more players or teams end up with the same score, tiebreak rules will be utilized to determine the winner.
