#### **PRIZES**

Trophies will be awarded for winners in the following age groups Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 15 and Under 18. Additional trophies will be awarded for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the various age categories contingent on the number of entrants, in addition merit trophies will be awarded for good performances.

Kindly take note that in order to be eligible for any WA State Champion or individual prize, players must achieve a score of 50% or greater (i.e., 4.5/9). If two or more players or teams end up with the same score, tiebreak rules will be utilized to determine the winner.
