Format:	All Matches are played over four boards.			
	Each Division will be e permitted. The format f	A five team Division will not be rately.		
Match Rules:	Each team can have up to six players. No player may play for more than one team.			
	Players shall be listed in descending order according to ACF rating with the exception that the team captain may decide the order when players are within 50 points of each other.			
	A team captain may request an exemption (e.g., due to fielding an under-rated player). Such a request must be made to the Organizer at the time of registering the team. Unrated players or players without an ACF rating shall be listed by the team captain using their best judgement of playing strength. Exemptions and the listing of unrated players are all subject to the discretion of the Organizer.			
	Once Round 1 has started, the player list cannot be changed except for the inclusion of new reserves if a team has less than six players. Any new reserve must be lower rated then all other listed players.			
	Discussion between players about a match situation and team tactics in accepting a draw or playing on for a win is allowed provided no discussion about any player's current game or position occurs.			
Time Control:	60 minutes with 10 second increment from move 1.
