

# 2025 South West Chess Festival Margaret River

The South West Chess Festival this year comprises two tournaments – the traditional South West Open and the new South West Allegro.

The South West Open is an ACF-rated CAWA Grand Prix event. It incorporates the WA Country Championship, awarded to the highest-scoring WA player residing outside the Perth Metropolitan Area.

The South West Allegro is an ACF-rated event limited to U1500 (ACF) and unrated players. This event provides an opportunity for players who may be new to tournament chess to play over-the-board chess. There is no requirement to record moves.

Format:	Swiss (Dutch variant), with six rounds in the Open and nine in the Allegro. Vega software (JaVaFo engine) for pairings. FIDE Laws of Chess apply.			
Time Controls:	Open: 60 minutes with 10 second increment Allegro: 15 minutes with 3 second increment

Entry Closing Date:	9:00pm on Friday 12th of September. Late entries (with a \$10 fee) at Arbiter's discretion.			
Entry Fee:	Entry fee for the Open is \$60. Entry fee for the Allegro is \$30.
