TOURNAMENT

Two separate tournaments will be held, namely the Under 18, and Under 12 categories.

TITLES

Top scoring participant: 2025 WA Junior Allegro Chess Champion and Girls Allegro Champion. 2025 WA Junior Allegro Under 12 Allegro Chess Champion and Best Girl Under 12s Allegro Champion.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded for winners in the following age groups Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 15 and Under 18. Additional trophies will be awarded for 2nd and 3rd in the various age categories contingent on the number of entrants, in addition merit trophies will be awarded for good performances for all age groups.

Kindly take note that in order to be eligible for any WA State Champion or individual prize, players must achieve a score of 50% or greater (i.e., 4.5/9). If necessary, playoffs will be used to decide individual State Champion titles. Otherwise, if two or more players end up with the same score, tiebreak rules will be utilized to determine the higher placed player.
