Format:	7 round Swiss, open to all players. FIDE Laws of Chess apply. All players must record their moves. All players are reminded of Article 11.3, forbidding the possession of electronic devices and information during games, and requiring all electronic devices to be switched off and stored in a separate bag. The same article also forbids any communication between players and spectators relating to games that are in progress.

Time Control:	90 minutes, with an increment of 30 seconds per move.		
Schedule:	Note: Players may take up to two half point byes in Rounds 1-5 only. Any such requests must be made in writing, and must be received prior to the start of the preceding round.
